

A Few Words about Passwords

As a student in the part-time LLM program, you will need to remember two sets of usernames and passwords. They're both important; we strongly suggest you commit them to memory, as you will need them throughout your time here, and it is often very inconvenient not to have them available. The table below outlines the differences:

Username/Password Type Characteristics	Passport York Username/ Password	Course Website Username/ Password
Controlled by	York University Central Accounts	Osgoode Professional Development
How you get them	Self-created (see the link below)	Assigned to you by your Graduate Program Assistant (Collette, Deirdre or Nikita)
What you might use them for (including but not limited to)	Student account balance; grades; library research; wire- less internet access at OPD and Main Campus	Accessing all course materials; including handouts; Power- points and exams; accessing archived lectures
What happens if you forget the username or password	Very bad things	Very bad things
