THE CURRICULUM

Osgoode Professional Development's various LLM specializations provide graduate level learning across a number of disciplines. In the two-year Part-time General LLM, you will choose courses from any of our available specializations during your time of study, and have the flexibility to complete the program according to your schedule.

Degree Requirements

- Option I**
 - 30 credits of coursework chosen from the specializations offered during your period of enrollment in the program;
 - Advanced Legal Research Workshop; and
 - An independent Major Research Paper (70 pages) [6 credits].

- Option II**
 - 36 credits of coursework chosen from the specializations offered during your period of enrollment in the program; and
 - A significant research paper (30 pages) completed for one of the courses.

Students in the General LLM must make their course selection in consultation with the Program Director. Not every course will be available in any given semester due to the fact that our specializations are not offered annually.

TUITION AND FEES

Tuition and fees for the Part-time LLM are \$18,660. This includes the cost of course materials. Tuition and fees are payable in six equal installments of \$3,110 over the course of the program. In addition, a \$15 administrative charge is levied by the Faculty of Graduate Studies for each payment processed. Light meals are provided for students attending classes in person in Toronto.

Tuition fees are set by the York University Board of Governors and are subject to change at any time. Students who take longer than six terms to complete their program may be subject to additional tuition charges.
