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## LLM SPECIALIZING IN BUSINESS LAW

The degree requirements will be satisfied upon the completion of 36 credits. There are two options for completing this degree:

### Option I [36 credits]

- The **required courses** for Business Law [18 credits]
- 12 additional credits of coursework, at least 6 of which must be courses from the Business Law-related electives\*
- A Major Research Paper (70 pages) in the Business Law field [6 credits]
- Advanced Legal Research Workshop\*\*

### Option II [36 credits]

- The **required courses** for Business Law [18 credits]
- 18 additional credits of coursework, at least 12 of which must be courses from the Business Law-related electives\*
- A Significant Research Paper (30 pages) as a means of evaluation for one of the Business Law required courses or -related electives\*\*

\* Please consult the [Business LLM schedule](#) for required courses and Business Law-related electives currently scheduled. Students are advised to consult the [term schedules](#) for additional course offerings outside of the Business Law required courses and -related electives (up to six credits of these course offerings can be taken during students' period of enrollment).

\*\* The Advanced Legal Research Workshop is required for all students who wish to complete a Major Research Paper and does not count towards the 36 credits required to complete the degree. The Advanced Legal Research Workshop is not required for students writing a Significant Research Paper but is strongly recommended in order for students to review writing and research skills. In general, the Advanced Legal Research Workshop is offered every term. Please consult the [term schedule](#) for dates. The **required courses** for Business Law are:

- Boards of Directors [3 credits]
- Corporate Governance [3 credits]
- Corporate Remedies [3 credits]
- Corporate Transactions [3 credits]
- Corporate Finance [3 credits]
- Advanced Corporate Law [3 credits]
